What Students Do

Students explore a variety of healthcare professions, gain insight into daily responsibilities, and develop essential professional and technical skills that support their future success in the healthcare field.

Industry Involvement

IU Health engages students as sophomores in apprentice programs and works with them through graduation. IU Health staff directly oversee and communicate with CAHS to support the program. After

graduation, students can seek employment with IU Health or enroll into a two- or four-year degree program.
