



High School Diploma Seals with Work-Based Learning Requirements

Beginning with the Class of 2029, [Indiana's new graduation requirements](#) allow students to earn up to six Diploma Seals, all which demonstrate the student's readiness for college, careers, or military service. Three (3) of the six (6) Diploma Seals require students to complete a WBL experience:

Enrollment Honors PLUS Seal

75+ hours of WBL as well as:

- Complete a specific set of courses aligned with college admission requirements
- Earn a "C" or higher in all classes & a cumulative "B" average

Complete **one** of the following:

- Earn 4 credits in AP, IB, or Cambridge courses
- Earn 6 college credits
- Score a 1250 on the SAT
- Score a 26 on the ACT
- Earn 2 of the following:
 - 3 college credits
 - 2 credits in AP courses and take the exams
 - 2 credits in IB courses and take the exams
 - 2 credits in Cambridge courses and take the exams

- Earn a [Credential of Value](#), including the [Indiana College Core](#)
- Demonstrate skill development in communication, collaboration, and work ethic

Employment Honors Seal

150+ hours of WBL as well as:

Complete **one** of the following:

- A [credential of value](#) aligned to a specific occupation
- 3 courses in a CTE pathway
- An approved career preparation experience aligned to Indiana's CSA program
- An approved, locally-created pathway

Meet the attendance goal by:

- completing at least one school year with no more than 3 days of unexcused absences; **or**
- having no more than 3 unexcused absences during the WBL experience(s)
- Demonstrate skill development in communication, collaboration, and work ethic

Employment Honors PLUS Seal

650+ hours of WBL as well as:

- Earn the Employment Honors Seal (see the middle column)
- [Earn a credential of value](#), including the [Indiana College Core](#)
- Demonstrate skill development in any additional skills determined locally
